## QUESTIONS?

### WHY SHOULD I RECYCLE?

Recycling is good for the environment. It saves resources, prevents pollution, supports public health, saves money and avoids landfills. Recycling also saves energy. Seventy-five percent of all waste is recyclable.

### DO I NEED TO SEPARATE GLASS, METAL, PLASTIC AND PAPER?

No. Waste Management Company runs a single-stream recycling program, meaning all recyclable materials may be placed in the same container. It will be sorted at their facility.

### HOW DO I GET AN EDGEWORTH BOROUGH RECYCLING CONTAINER?

You may pick up and pay for either a larger can or smaller bin at the various days, times and location – see attached schedule

### WHAT IF NEED ANOTHER CONTANER?

After a few months of curbside recycling, if you need a another container due to higher than expected volume, contact the Borough Office to make arrangements to pick up and purchase another one

### WILL THERE STILL BE RECYCLING DAYS FOR UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS LISTED ON THE OTHER SIDE?

Yes. Edgeworth Borough, along with our consortium municipalities, will continue to host special days for residents (usually in early May and November) to bring the following materials to a specified location for recycling:

Paint	Computers	Cabinets

### CAN I STILL USE THE DROP-OFF RECYCLING CENTER ON ROUTE 65?

Yes. Edgeworth Borough will continue to maintain the recycling center especially for our residents who live on long, narrow, private lanes and drives that the curbside recycle truck cannot access. All Edgeworth residents may continue to use the recycling center on Ohio River Boulevard at Chestnut Road.

### WHAT DAY IS CURBSIDE RECYCLING PICK-UP?

The Waste Management Company recycling truck will pick up on Wednesdays – the same as our trash pick-up day. If pick-up falls on a major holiday, the recycling will be picked up on Thursday – same day as trash collection.
