

EDGEWORTH BOROUGH COUNCIL
BUDGET HEARING MINUTES
December 16, 2025

MEETING was called to order at 6:45 p.m. with Council President Joseph T. Hoepp presiding and the following members of Council and officials of the Borough present: Mr. Joseph T. Hoepp, Mr. Ivan T. Hofmann, Mr. Gregory Marlovits, Mrs. Elizabeth Genter, Mrs. Katherine D. Larsen, Ms. Rebecca Mahr Cartus, Mayor Gary L. Smith, Borough Manager Ellen E. Politi, and Mr. Brendan Lucas representing the Borough Solicitor.

The purpose of the Budget Hearing was to ascertain the views of any interested parties with respect to the proposed budget for 2026.

Mr. Hoepp stated that for the twenty-third consecutive year, there is no proposed property tax increase for Edgeworth residents. Mrs. Politi highlighted scheduled expenditure funds earmarked for the replacement of the traffic signal at the intersection of Beaver Road and Academy Avenue, paving, the Sidewalk Replacement Program, and the purchase of new vehicles and equipment for both the Public Works and Police Departments.

After further discussion, Mr. Hoepp opened the floor to public comment.
