

EDGEWORTH BOROUGH COUNCIL  
BUDGET HEARING MINUTES  
December 19, 2023

MEETING was called to order at 6:45 p.m. with Council President Joseph T. Hoepp presiding and the following members of Council and officials of the Borough present: Mr. Joseph T. Hoepp, Mr. David T. Aloe, Mr. Ivan T. Hofmann, Mr. Daniel S. Wilson, Mr. Gregory Marlovits, Mrs. Elizabeth Genter, Mrs. Katherine Larsen, Mayor Gary L. Smith, Borough Manager John F. Schwend, and Mr. Brendan Lucas representing the Borough Solicitor.

The purpose of the Budget Hearing was to ascertain the views of any interested parties with respect to the proposed budget for 2024.

Mr. Wilson stated that for the twenty-first consecutive year, there is no proposed property tax increase for Edgeworth residents. Mr. Schwend highlighted scheduled expenditure funds earmarked for repairs to the Beaver Road wall, relocating the sewer line beneath the Edgeworth Club, and grant funding requests related to the second phase of the Church Lane sewer lining, and ADA parking improvements at the Borough building.

After further discussion, Mr. Hoepp opened the floor to public comment.

Mr. Harris asked whether street light upgrades on Irwin Drive are included in the budget. Mr. Schwend explained that street light upgrades and maintenance are the responsibility of Duquesne Light Company, and are not line items within the budget; however he will reach out to Duquesne Light representatives to address the matter.
