

**ORDINANCE NO. 550**

**BOROUGH OF EDGEWORTH  
ALLEGHENY COUNTY PENNSYLVANIA**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BOROUGH OF EDGEWORTH CODE  
CHAPTER 121 – VEHICLE OPERATION AND STORAGE, TO RESTRICT STORAGE  
OF ROLL-OFF DUMPSTERS, STORAGE CONTAINERS AND HOURS OF  
OPERATION  
FOR CONTRACTOR WORK**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Edgeworth (the "Borough") currently maintains a Vehicle Operation and Storage Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council has deemed it to be in the Borough's best interest to amend said ordinance to restrict the storage of roll-off dumpsters and to further restrict the hours in which contractors may perform work within the Borough.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Edgeworth, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania that Chapter 121 of the Borough's Code of Ordinances, (the "Vehicle Operation and Storage Ordinance"), is amended as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Section 121-5 of the Vehicle Operation and Storage Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful to park or store any boat, trailer, roll-off dumpster, storage container or other vehicle, except for passenger cars and pickup trucks, on any street, right-of-way or highway in the Borough, except as may be expressly permitted by the provisions of Chapter 130, Zoning, of the Code of the Borough of Edgeworth. Boats, trailers, other vehicles (but not including passenger cars and pickup trucks), roll-off dumpsters, or storage containers may only be stored in the side or rear yard of a property and only when they are screened from public view. Roll off dumpsters, storage containers and trailers may be stored in any yard of a property without screening on a temporary basis, not to exceed three consecutive weeks in any year, with written permission from the Borough Manager upon application. The Manager may grant one additional three week extension for extensive renovation projects that have a building permit and are being diligently pursued. No such object may block a sidewalk, and it must be placed at a location that is the furthest as reasonably possible from the street and any adjacent property. The Manager may establish procedures to implement the requirements of this section. Borough Council may by resolution impose a fee for any request under this section.

**SECTION 2.** Section 121-7 of the Vehicle Operation and Storage Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:


It shall only be lawful for a person to carry on any building, commercial painting of a structure (interior or exterior), commercial contracting or commercial lawn or garden maintenance, road or equipment maintenance, construction, excavation, trenching or the operation of construction or maintenance equipment or of trucks and vehicles in connection therewith ("Work") between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday, and between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Friday and Saturday. It shall be unlawful to conduct Work any time on Sundays or on a federally recognized holiday. Work may only be performed at other times by special written permission of the Borough Manager. Such permission shall be granted only if it is demonstrated that the Work must proceed as a matter of emergency or that it can be carried on in such a manner or in such a place that the residents of the Borough will not be annoyed or disturbed by such Work. The emergency repair of water lines, gas lines, sewer lines or other utilities shall not be subject to the foregoing restrictions.

**SECTION 3.** If any section subsection sentence clause or phrase or portion of this document is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction such shall be deemed a separate distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion thereof.
