\* Edgeworth Borough Zoning Ordinance Section 121-5 Ordinance No. 550

*It shall be unlawful to park or store any boat, trailer, roll-off dumpster, storage container or other vehicle, except for passenger cars and pickup trucks, on any street, right-of-way or highway in the Borough, except as may be expressly permitted by the provisions of Chapter 130, Zoning, of the Code of the Borough of Edgeworth. Boats, trailers, other vehicles (but not including passenger cars and pickup trucks), roll-off dumpsters, or storage containers may only be stored in the side or rear yard of a property and only when they are screened from public view. Roll off dumpsters, storage containers and trailers may be stored in any yard or property without screening on a temporary basis, **not to exceed three consecutive weeks in a year**, with written permission from the Borough Manager upon application. The Manager may grant one additional three week extension for extensive renovation projects that have a building permit and are being diligently pursued. No such object may block a sidewalk, and it must be placed at a location that is the furthest as reasonably possible from the street and any adjacent property. The Manager may establish procedures to implement the requirements of this section. Borough Council may by resolution impose a fee for any request under this section.*
